 - M.Tech. in Geo-Informatics.

b. Deemed University Status

Members advised to go for Deemed University status only after successful implementation of Autonomous Status.

c. Autonomous Status

Since the application was submitted to UGC, Members advised to do the follow up work in this regard. It is also suggested that all the statutory requirements should be fulfilled before getting the approval from UGC for Autonomous Status.

Faculty skills in Teaching & Research

The college is collaborating with IUCEE to bring experts from various US Universities to conduct workshops at National level to improve faculty skills.

Members suggested

- To contact JNTUK for FDP. They felt that the college should have a policy to depute faculty members under QIP to pursue their Ph.D. at premium institutions like IITs and NITs.
- To introduce a scheme to encourage the teachers and the students to come out with research publications at national/international level.
- To develop interaction with various labs such as DRDO.
- To introduce Best Teacher Awards for encouragement to staff.
- To provide exposure and hands on experience on tools like DB2.

e. IEEE Women Congress

The IEEE Section of SVECW is organizing 'Women in Engineering Congress' on March 6th & 7th 2012. The members appreciated the efforts made in this regard.

f. TEQIP

The following resolutions were passed with regard to TEQIP.

- 1) The Principal is authorized to constitute the committees as per the requirement with internal members for the smooth conduct of the Institution, implementation of the Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP-II) and also to reconstitute as and when necessity arises.
- 2) To establish four funds Corpus fund, Faculty Development Fund, Equipment Replacement Fund and Maintenance Fund with annual contribution of 0.5% of annual total recurring expenditure of the SVECW during the TEQIP-II project period.
- 3) To authorize Principal to open and operate the separate accounts for the above mentioned funds and TEQIP Fund account.
- 4) To get NBA accreditation for all eligible UG and PG programs in engineering stream.
- 5) To process the existing autonomous application with UGC and to obtain the autonomous status by next academic year.
- 6) The following financial powers are delegated to the Principal and other functionaries
 - a. Principal is authorized for Rs.50 lakh for single purchase order.
 - b. Head of the Department is authorized for Rs. 1 lakh for single purchase order.
- 7) To conduct BOG meeting every Quarter in a year.
- 8) To start new PG course Geo informatics, to establish new laboratories and modernize laboratories of Existing PG courses.
- 9) To allocate the Budget for the activities as mentioned in Institutional Development Proposal of TEQIP-II.

10) Principal is authorized to carry out the projected activities specified in Institutional Development Proposal of TEQIP-II.

g. Improving Placements

Members advised to take appropriate steps to improve placements.

Sri G. Ramanathan, CEO, Guru Synergies, Chennai volunteered for Internship Placements and Industrial visit to Guru Synergies by students.

Smt. U.V. Ratna Kumari, University Nominee suggested that at least 3 students for each branch should be sent to Core Companies for live projects. She also suggested that cash prizes may be given to the Toppers/Good Rankers.

h. Workshops/Symposia

It is decided to conduct 'Medha Milan-2012', a national level technical symposium for women engineering students on 10th & 11th February 2012.
