

1. Technospectra

In this event two candidates will be playing together simultaneously within the time limit of 2 minutes. Firstly they need to choose one of the electronic symbol from the chart and they need to identify the terminology related to that symbol from the other chart displayed on the board. If they can't identify the terminology related to that symbol they have a chance of choosing other symbol. Once they choose the other symbol they don't have chance of identifying the previous symbol terminology. It is conducted for both 2nd and 3rd year students after 4:20pm. Number of Participants are 72.



2. Technothon

In "Technothon" we showed them a chart which consists of 7/7 grid in which the components are written. The components which are placed in these grids are used to make a circuit. In the chart we had written the 8 circuits names on the right side of grid. They need to choose one of the circuit from that 8 and identify the components related to that circuit and say the number in which the component is placed. In the span of 1 min how many circuits they can tell is of their wish either it is wrong or correct if once they skipped to other circuit they had no chance of choosing previous circuit. In this event 2nd and 3rd year students participated and it is conducted after 4:20pm. Number of participants are 203.



3. Think and Spell

In "Think and Spell" we made the participants into a group of three members. In this event one of the member from the group will be enacting and the rest two will be guessing the electronic device name and need to arrange the letters. The one who is enacting need to choose a number from 1 to 20. It is conducted for 1st year students from 3:30pm onwards. Number of Participants are 203



4. Techocharade

In this event we made the participants into a group of three members. One of the member from the group will be enacting and the rest two will be guessing the electronic circuit name and arranging it's letters. The one who is enacting need to choose a number between 1 to 16. It is conducted for 2nd and 3rd year students from 4:20pm onwards. Number of Participants are 110.



5. Blast the Thought

We divided the participants into a group of two members. The time limit is 1 minute. One among them will be blindfolded and the other member should pick a chit from a box in which different color names are written but shouldn't reveal it to others. The blindfolded person searches for the balloon by following the instructions of other person and as soon as she catches the balloon she again picks a chit in which there will be a question to be answered. Both the team members can cordially discuss and give one answer. This event is conducted for 1st year students from 4:20pm onwards. Number of participants are 140.



6. Venture For Lives

In "Venture for Lives", we divided the participants into groups consisting of 9 members. Firstly they need to answer a question which is posed by our student coordinators within a time limit of 30 seconds. After discussing with their team members one of them need to answer the question. If the answer is correct they need to pick a chit from the box provided. The box consists of 5 chits which include- gun, double-gun, fire, heart, bomb. If she picks gun then she can eliminate one person from opposite team. If she picks double-gun she can eliminate two members from opposite team. If she picks fire her entire team will be eliminated. If it is bomb the person who selected the chit will be eliminated. If she picks heart their team will get one life and they can get back the person who got eliminated. It is conducted for 2nd and 3rd year students from 4:20pm onwards. Number of participants are 215.



7. IETE Poster League

IETE STUDENTS' FORUM conducted "IETE POSTER LEAGUE (IPL)" on 04-01-2019 from 3:30 pm onwards. It is a technical poster presentation conducted by II and III year student coordinators. Some of the 1st year students participated in it. They presented their posters on one of the topics announced well before. Each team consisted of minimum 2 members. Faculty members and students of all years visited the poster presentation and made it successful. The winners of this presentation are declared based on maximum number of votes they got. It is conducted for 1st year students.



8. Hobby Project Expo

IETE STUDENTS' FORUM conducted "Hobby Project Expo" on 30-07-2018 from 3:30 pm onwards. It is a technical event conducted by II and III year student coordinators. All the III year ECE students had participated in it. They presented their projects based on the core concepts related to integrated circuits, sensors, Arduinos, etc... Students were divided into 51 batches and each batch containing four members each. All the faculty members and the students of all the years had visited the EXPO and made it successful. The winners of this EXPO were declared based on the voting system. The batch

which gained maximum votes are declared as winners. It is conducted for 3rd year students, number of participants are 204.

9. IETE Championship 2k19

IETE STUDENTS' FORUM conducted IETE Championship 2k19 on 1-2-2019 from 4:20pm onwards. It is conducted for 1st, 2nd and 3rd year students. This championship includes three levels.



The first event is “CIRCUIT CELLAR”, it is a written event in which there will be a grid and they need to identify the technical words. The participants who got selected are promoted to next event named “RAFFLE FOR QUEST” in which at first every team is allotted with 500 points and 3 levels of questions will be asked later they need to bet the answer with the points they are given. If the answer is correct the points of the team to which the question is asked will be tripled and for other teams the points will be doubled if their answer is correct. The teams who performed well are promoted to the last event named “ACOLYTE CANVASS”. It is an outdoor event in which 2 students per team will be playing, one of them need to step on the path drawn. The other person should answer the questions posed, if they answered the question they should walk on the path until there is a turn. Within 2 min they need to answer maximum questions and should not step on the line path.



10. Electrobuzz

It is conducted on 30-11-2018 from 3:30pm onwards. It is a technical written event. The question paper consists of electronic words and they must write words relating to electronic relating to each letter in given words.-The students who wrote maximum words are winners .It is conducted for 2nd and 3rd year students. Number of participants are 133.



11. IETE DAY 2019

IETE STUDENTS'FORUM conducted "IETE DAY" on 5-02-2019 from 3:00 PM onwards. This event was organized by all the II year, III year and IV year student coordinators. All the students have participated in this event. On behalf of IETE DAY we have conducted many spot events they are "ZOOM IN", "LAUREL SORT", "PROPEL UR THOUGHT", and ended with the prize distribution.

EVENT DESCRIPTION: "PROPEL UR THOUGHT"

We have given them a pair of dice to them they need to propel them on a board provided to them.
