3. FUTURE PLANS

A) Implementation plan for TEQIP-II

a1. Teaching Assistantships:

Teaching Assistantships will be given to the students who are admitted into the PG programmes from the academic year 2012-13 and PG admissions are under process.

a2. Faculty and Staff Development:

- i) Six FDP/workshop/conferences for faculty and one workshop for staff will be organized before 31-03-2013. Faculty and staff from each department will be encouraged to participate in one FDP as per their Training need.
- ii) Faculty will be encouraged to register for Ph.D and course fee for the 2012-13 and other permissible expenses to do Research will be provided to the already registered candidates.
- iii) Every Faculty from each department needs to present paper at least one in national/international reputed conference.

a3. Enhanced Interaction with Industry:

More number of activities under I-I-I-C to be organized and the same to be reviewed once in fortnight.

a4. Institutional Management capacity enhancement :

Senior faculty will be asked to identify the courses and orientation programmes organized at reputed institutes and they will be deputed.

a5. Academic support for weak students:
