SHRI VISHNU ENGINEERING COLLEGE FOR WOMEN :: BHIMAVARAM ANTI RAGGING – PUNISHMENTS

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:

- 1. Cancellation of admission.
- 2. Suspension from attending classes.
- 3. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- 4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- 5. Withholding results.
- 6. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- 7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel, Mess and the like.
- 8. Rustication from the institution in case of any involvement in ragging.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.
- 10. Photography of the students who have involved in ragging and prima facie cases shall be displayed in the notice boards, conspicuous place and local news paper, besides criminal complaints.
- 11. Collective punishment when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified. The institution shall resort to collective punishment as a determent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.
