The minutes of meeting of SC/ST WELFARE COMMITTEE held on 28.07.2021

Decisions taken:

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The members reviewed the minutes of the previous meeting and necessary actions were taken.

1. Motivate students to utilize Scholarships/special facilities

The members suggested that the students should actively participate in academics, sports and extra circular activities. Below mentioned points were discussed:
