PREVIOUS ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING:

a. Confirmation of the minutes

The Council unanimously confirmed the minutes of the 13th Academic Council meeting, held on 25 November 2020, as previously circulated to all members.

14.2. RATIFICATION OF RESULTS:

The Council received a comprehensive presentation of the examination results and accompanying analysis, which the members noted and commended.

14.3.R-20 B.TECH./M.TECH./MBA COURSE STRUCTURE

The Council reviewed the R-20 course structures for the B.Tech., M.Tech., and MBA programmes—formulated in accordance with APSCHE guidelines—and unanimously granted their approval.

14.4. Foreign Languages (Certification) / Internship / Certificate Course / EPICS

The Council observed that, under the R-18 undergraduate curriculum, each of the above courses currently carries three credits but no associated marks. To ensure these credits

contribute to the calculation of the cumulative grade-point average (CGPA), the members resolved that:

- ✓ Each course shall be evaluated internally for a maximum of 50 marks.
 - ✓ A minimum score of 40 percent (i.e., 20/50) shall be required to secure a pass grade.
- This revision will be reflected in the course structure and implemented henceforth.

14.5. Ratification of Board of Studies Minutes (I & II Year)

The minutes of the Board of Studies meetings for B.Tech. (Mechanical Engineering), B.Tech. (Electronics and Communication Engineering), and the MBA programme were presented to the Council. After review, the members ratified the minutes in full.

14.6. UGC Expert Team Visit for Extension of Autonomous Status

The Council was informed that a University Grants Commission (UGC) Expert Committee visited the College on 8–9 April 2021 to evaluate the institution for renewal of its autonomous status. The visiting team comprised:
