## **MINUTES**

### **15.1. Welcome and introductory remarks by the Chairman of Academic Council**

- ✓ At the outset of the 14<sup>th</sup> Academic Council session, the Chairman extended a cordial welcome to every member present and formally introduced the University-nominated representatives—**Dr G.V.R. Prasada Raju** Rector & DE I/C JNTUK, **Dr R. Srinivasa Rao**, Director, Academic Planning, JNTUK and **Dr K. Sahadevaiah** Department of CSE, UCEK, JNTUK. The Chairman expressed appreciation for their attendance despite demanding schedules, after which Council members reciprocated by introducing themselves to the University Nominees.
- ✓ Thereafter, **Dr G. Srinivasa Rao**, Principal of SVECW, assumed the role of Chairperson and delivered an overview of the day's agenda. Following his presentation, the Council proceeded to deliberate upon each formal agenda item; the ensuing discussions, resolutions and decisions are recorded in the sections that follow.

### **15.2. To confirm the minutes of 14<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting held on 15.04.2021.**

- ✓ Mr P. Surya Prakash Varma, Member-Secretary, formally presented the minutes of the Academic Council meeting held on 15<sup>th</sup> April 2021. Following a brief review, the Council unanimously resolved to confirm the record as an accurate account of proceedings, with the motion for adoption duly seconded by Dr. G.V.R. Prasada Raju.

### **15.3. To review the action taken on the previous meetings held on 15.04.2021.**

- ✓ The Chairman tabled a comprehensive compliance report detailing every action undertaken in response to the resolutions adopted at the 14<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting. The document enumerated each recommendation, the corresponding measures instituted, timelines achieved, and the performance indicators now in place for continued monitoring.

### **15.4. To review and ratify the examination Results**

- ✓ The results and result analysis were presented to the members, who acknowledged and appreciated the efforts taken in this regard.

Dr. G.V.R. Prasada Raju, Rector and Director of Evaluation (I/c), JNTUK, advised that senior faculty members should be appointed as Chief Examiners while selecting both internal and external faculty members for the valuation process.

The Principal informed the members that the revaluation results led to changes in only 6% to 7% of the total results.

#### **15.5. To ratify the revised Curriculum of 8 UG-B.Tech. Programmes, 4 PG-M.Tech. Programmes and 1 PG-M.B.A. Programme to be offered under Choice Based Credit System for the AY 2021-2022**

##### **Curriculum Revision under Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS)**

The Chairman tabled the newly revised curricula, framed in accordance with the Choice-Based Credit System, covering:

- ✓ **8 Undergraduate B.Tech. programmes**
- ✓ **4 Postgraduate M.Tech. programmes**
- ✓ **1 Postgraduate M.B.A. programme**

He confirmed that each syllabus and course structure had been scrutinised and unanimously adopted by the relevant Departmental Boards of Studies prior to this meeting.

After careful examination of the proposed credit distributions, course outcomes, and programme-specific objectives, the Academic Council **resolved—without dissent—to ratify and approve** the revised curricula in toto. Departments are authorised to implement the new frameworks with immediate effect, beginning with the forthcoming academic session, and to ensure all pertinent information is circulated to faculty, students, and supporting offices.

### **Curriculum Revision Status and Council Resolution**

- ✓ The Chairman informed the Academic Council that the revised curricula for all seven B.Tech., four M.Tech., and one M.B.A. programmes have been fully aligned with prevailing UGC norms, while operating within the broader regulatory frameworks prescribed by AICTE and the affiliating university, JNTU Kakinada. In the course-mapping exercise, each programme's learning modules have been explicitly linked to its Programme Outcomes (POs), thereby ensuring coherence with the stated Mission and Vision of the individual departments.
- ✓ He further confirmed that, throughout the redesign process, comprehensive feedback was solicited and systematically analysed from the full spectrum of stakeholders—students, faculty, alumni, industry partners, and external academic experts. This consultative approach has enriched both the structure and the content of the new syllabi.
- ✓ Following deliberation, the Academic Council unanimously resolved to ratify the revised course structures for all identified programmes—Eight undergraduate B.Tech., four postgraduate M.Tech., and the postgraduate M.B.A.—and authorised their immediate implementation in the forthcoming academic session.

### **15.6. To ratify the revised syllabus forwarded in respective Board of Studies Meetings held during June and July of 2021 of 8 B.Tech. Programmes, 4 M.Tech. Programmes and 1 M.B.A. Programme to be offered under Choice Based Credit System for the AY 2021-22.**

- ✓ The chairman of the council moved for approval of 8 UG-B.Tech., 4 PG-M.Tech., 1 PG-M.B.A. Board of Studies meetings and meeting is handed over to the respective Chairpersons of the BoS:

**15.6.1.** The BoS Chairperson of UG-B.Tech Civil Engineering, presented the BoS Minutes of the Meeting and four year course structure to the council for ratification and highlighted the following details:

- The total number of courses – 96, out of which 22 are New Courses, 38 courses are offered under CBCS / Department Electives and 9 courses are discontinued.
- 54 courses are identified related to Employability, 36 courses are recognized as Skill Development courses and 11 courses considered for Entrepreneurship.

- Towards Internships, Field Projects and Research Projects 56 courses are acknowledged. In addition, 02 courses are offered as Value added Courses.

- The total number of courses – 96, out of which 17 are New Courses, 35 courses are offered under CBCS / Department Electives and 08 courses are discontinued.
- 54 courses are identified related to Employability, 36 courses are recognized as Skill Development courses and 6 courses considered for Entrepreneurship.
- Towards Internships, Field Projects and Research Projects 35 courses are acknowledged. In addition, 02 courses are offered as Value added Courses.

- Towards Internships, Field Projects and Research Projects 29 courses are acknowledged. In addition, 01 courses are offered as Value added Courses.

#### **15.7. Introduction of Honors and Minors in the B.Tech Programme.**

- ✓ The Chairman briefed the members on the introduction of Honors and Minors in the B.Tech programme. As per the latest AICTE Process Handbook for 2021–2022, the list of eligible courses has been clearly specified for each branch. Accordingly, students are now required to choose only one course from the specified list under their respective branches for pursuing the Honors programme henceforth.

#### **15.8. Introduction of ARTS Course under CBCS**

- ✓ The Chairman informed the members of the Academic Council about the introduction of ARTS courses as part of the Choice Based Credit System



(CBCS), effective from the academic year 2021–2022. These courses are to be offered as mandatory courses for all second-year undergraduate students.

- ✓ The Chairman also briefed the Council on the various ARTS courses to be offered and explained the procedure for students to opt for a particular course from the available options.

#### **15.9. Introduction of New Undergraduate Programme – B.Tech in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning**

- ✓ The Chairman informed the members of the Academic Council about the introduction of a new undergraduate programme, B.Tech in Artificial Intelligence and Machine Learning, commencing from the academic year 2021–2022.
- ✓ The Chairman also briefed the members on the existing undergraduate programmes being offered by the institution, along with their respective intake capacities.

#### **15.10. Promotion of New Learning Methodologies through ICT**

- ✓ The Chairman emphasized the need to promote innovative learning methodologies by effectively integrating Information and Communication Technology (ICT) into the teaching-learning process. This initiative aims to enhance student engagement, improve learning outcomes, and align with the objectives of digital and outcome-based education.

#### **15.11. Any other item with the permission of the chair**

- ✓ The Chairman informed the members that 53 faculty members are Ph.D. holders, and an additional 50 faculty members are currently pursuing their Ph.D. programs.
- ✓ Dr. G.V.R. Prasada Raju, Rector and Director of Evaluation (I/c), JNTUK, advised that the remaining faculty members should be encouraged to enroll in and complete their Ph.D. at the earliest, as a Ph.D. will soon be a mandatory requirement for ratification, even for the post of Assistant Professor, as per university norms.
