#### 16.8. ANY OTHER ITEM WITH THE PERMISSION OF THE CHAIR:

### a) Diagnostic Test for I B.Tech. Students

Members are informed of the Diagnostic Test conducted for the I B.Tech. students of 2021-22 admitted batch in order to assess the students in Digital Literacy, English, Mathematics and Motivation Style. Total 753 out of 894 students are attempted the test.

Based on the assessment of the above test, the following action points are prepared.

- A tips and tricks class in mathematics "Limits and Integration" for ECE and EEE one batch and for ME & CE one batch coordinated by Maths dept.
- ➤ Remedial class in Mathematics I for B & C sections of IT branch students coordinated by Maths dept.
- ➤ Conducting class in the use of Virtual drives (Google Drive, OneDrive. etc.), communication tools and use of AI-enabled devices to all the students coordinated by Dean ICT.
- Conducting classes by focusing on Idioms, Phrasal Verbs and Question Tags coordinated by English dept.

# b) Additional Matters Raised for the Council's Consideration

- ✓ **Industry-led instruction** for AI & ML and Mechanical Engineering students was commended; members recommended extending this initiative to all departments.
- ✓ The Council endorsed participation in the ARC course offered by APSSDC, provided its duration is equal to or exceeds the internship/certification period approved by the respective Boards of Studies.
- ✓ Members encouraged **inter-departmental student projects**, noting that such projects may be recognised as summer-internship equivalents.
- ✓ The Council noted that **four programmes** currently hold NBA Tier-I accreditation and are preparing for reaccreditation.
- ✓ Members were informed that the institution has submitted its application for the **second NAAC cycle** as an autonomous institution.

- ✓ The appointment of Mr K. S. N. Raju (Assistant Professor, ECE) as the new Controller of Examinations, replacing Mr P. Surya Prakash Varma, was ratified.
- ✓ In line with AICTE regulations, the Council approved the inclusion of **NEAT** courses for up to 40 credits within the curriculum.
